



VISA INFORMATION

2017 ITTF CHALLENGE BELGOSSTRAKH BELARUS OPEN

No visa needed for entering the Republic of Belarus for a period of 5 days for citizens of 80 countries (please, see the list) if they enter Belarus **via** the Airport Minsk–2 only.

In case you have a transit flight from Russian Federation you will need a transit Russian visa. Please, take care of that.

Those, who are planning to come to Belarus for more than 5 days, need to apply for a visa at the consular department of the Embassy of Belarus in their country or upon arrival at the Airport Minsk–2 (MSQ). In this case, the visa will be free of charge.

Belarus visa will be ensured by Belarus Table Tennis Federation and the Ministry of Sports and Tourism of the Republic of Belarus **free of charge** to all the players, coaches, medical staff, umpires, ITTF staff.

Required for visa invitation letter:

- Passport copy with all needed data (name, passport number, dates of issue and expiry)
- Information about the place of work (study) and position
- Information about the place of application (embassy, consular department, airport)
