Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.</p>	
21 INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS	<p>In the context of betting participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.</p>

23 NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER ASSOCIATION	<p>According to the 2017 ITTF World Tour Directives and SSI, we have to limit the number of entries to 200 players in total. Only the final entries are taken into consideration by the organizers and the Competition Manager for the participation of your players.</p> <p>For the ITTF World Tour: An association can enter a maximum of: Men and Women Singles: 6 players per Association (each gender) / 12 players for the Host Association (each gender) Men and Women Doubles: 2 pairs or 4 players per Association (each gender) / 3 pairs or 6 players for the Host Association (each gender) U21 Men and Women Singles: 4 players per Association (each gender)</p> <p>Additional entries will be put on a waiting list and accepted depending of the total number of entries.
